**Activities & Sightseeing**

**Day**

**Arrival, Lei Greeting, Transfer to Hotel**

2 hours

Aloha and Welcome to Hawaii! Upon arrival at Honolulu Airport, you will be met, and experience your first taste of Aloha Spirit with a **traditional fresh flower lei greeting**. Board your bus and transfer to your hotel. An equipment truck and driver are included today, and on your return day, to help transfer instruments. World renowned Waikiki Beach is waiting for you! Stroll along picturesque Kalakaua Ave. Visit the world famous International Market Place.



**Day**

**Pearl Harbor/USS Missouri Performance**

3 – 5 hours

Highly recommended

Depart for **Pearl Harbor**. Your visit will include the **U.S.S. Arizona Memorial**. View a movie about the attack on Pearl Harbor. Once the movie is over, you will take a short boat ride to the Memorial. Here you will witness the actual sunken hull where over 1000 servicemen were entombed during the December 7, 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor. Continue to the nearby **U.S.S. Missouri**, a legendary symbol of the end of World War II. Re-live history at the site where on September 2nd, 1945, the Japanese surrendered and ended World War II.



Optional **Tribute performance by your group at the U.S.S. Missouri** (subject to availability and approval). You will have an opportunity to take a group photo. Participants may purchase the souvenir photos following the performance. **Lunch is included.**



**Day**

**Grand Circle Island Tour, North Shore**

7 – 8 hours

Board bus for the **Grand Circle Island Tour** with North Shore swim and lunch. Drive along the slopes of Diamond Head, visit Kahala, view Hanauma Bay, Halona "Blow Hole", Eternity Beach, Waimanalo town and quaint beach, Pali Lookout, Helemano & Dole Plantation and maze, Hale'iwa Town, and the North Shore, world famous for its huge waves. Finally, stop at the Kualoa Nursery & Gardens and Byodo-In Buddhist Temple.



**Day**

**Honolulu Area Tour**

4 -5 hours

Enjoy a half day 60-mile tour revealing Hawaii's natural sites that people fall in love with. Lush tropical rain forest, rocky cliffs with incredible views of the blue Pacific Ocean. A worthwhile tour for all ages, so please join us for a great time!



**Day**                      **Whale Watching Eco Tour**

2 – 3 hours

Take a scenic cruise along Oahu’s coastline and view majestic Humpback Whales with expert narration. Enjoy an intimate experience with Hawaii’s humpback whales aboard a smooth-riding vessel along the beautiful Shores of Hawaii!



**Day**                      **Diamond Head Hike**

1 – 2 hours

Depart for a guided adventure of **Diamond Head Crater** where you will learn interesting information about the crater’s history, archaeology, flora and fauna. Your tour includes round trip transportation from your hotel. Hike through a dark tunnel (flash light needed) to the top of the crater ridge. Enjoy magnificent views of the Greater Honolulu area from the top of the crater.



**Day**                      **Hanauma Bay Snorkeling**

2 – 3 hours

Take a trip to **Hanauma Bay** located at a beautiful scenic Hawaii beach. Hanauma Bay is an extinct volcanic crater which has been filled by the ocean and today is a federally protected wildlife preserve. With over 450 species of tropical fish, Hanauma Bay is a popular Hawaii attraction enjoyed by visitors and residents for ocean activities such as snorkeling and scuba diving. About 20 to 30 percent of the fish at Hanauma Bay exist only in the Hawaiian Islands.



**Day**                      **Iolani Palace Museum**

1 – 2 hours

Take a tour in the middle of downtown Honolulu where **Iolani Palace** sits, the only royal palace in the United States. Built in 1882 by King David Kalakaua and his wife Queen Kapiolani, the palace had electricity and telephones even before the White House. King Kalakaua found inspiration for the design of the palace during his European travels, yet certain features attest to the fact that the palace was built in a place where the climate invites one outdoors. Experience one of the historic Hawaii’s historical landmarks.



**Day**                      **Luau at Paradise Cove**

3 – 4 hours

The **Paradise Cove Luau** is probably one of the best on the islands, with their own private beach and thatched village huts. You can participate in traditional games, and then head to the beach to watch the men bring in the traditional fishnets of Hukilau, a “pull together” long net. You will be entertained with Hawaiian music and dance and enjoy a true Hawaiian style feast.



**Day**                      **Hawaiian Adventures Water Park**

3 – 5 Hours

For a day of fun in the water, the **Hawaiian Adventures Water Park** is 25-acres of safe, clean family fun and excitement and is the **ONLY** water park on Hawaii! Located in the city of Kapolei on the driest and warmest side of the island of Oahu, you’ll rarely find a rainy day at Hawaiian Adventures.



**Day Polynesian Cultural Center**

5 – 6 Hours Depart for a full day excursion to the **Polynesian Cultural Center**. You will see a representation of the Polynesia nation islands, in one location. Stroll through the authentic 7 villages of Samoa, Tonga, Fiji, New Zealand, Tahiti, Marquesas and Hawaii. Experience the thrilling giant screen **IMAX** theater presentation and many live shows throughout the day. Lunch at the PCC is on your own.



**Polynesian Cultural Center - Optional Activities**

3 hours Plan to spend a full day and evening at the Polynesian Cultural Center. Experience a true Hawaiian **Luau**, or just a **Dinner Buffet**. Both meal options are followed by the **Horizons Polynesian live show** in the Center theater. An optional **Performance by your music ensemble** at the Polynesian Cultural Center (pending approval and availability).



1 – 2 hours For added attraction, visit the **Dole Maze** on your way to the Polynesian Cultural Center. Challenge and experience the world largest maze, a pineapple garden maze at the **Dole Plantation Center**. The Dole Plantation is an educational and tourist center, where you will learn all about Hawaii’s famous produce – the pineapple. This attraction can also be added to the **North Shore** tour.



**Day Sea Life Park**

1 – 2 Hours Visit the **Sea Life Park**, which is one of the main visitor attractions on Oahu. Get an up-close look at a variety of marine animals, such as dolphins, sea lions, penguins and rays. Activities include a dolphin cove, a stingray lagoon, a Hawaiian reef aquarium, an ocean theatre and much more. Personal encounters, such as swimming with dolphins and stingrays can also be booked.



**Day Waikiki Aquarium**

1 – 2 hours Depart for the **Waikiki Aquarium**, founded in 1904, and the third oldest public aquarium in the United States. It has been a part of the University of Hawaii since 1919, and is located next to a living reef on the Waikiki shoreline. Their exhibits, programs, and research focus on the aquatic life of Hawaii and the tropical Pacific. Over 2,500 organisms in their exhibits represent more than 420 species of aquatic animals. Every year, roughly 350,000 people visit the Waikiki Aquarium.



**Day Alii Kai Dinner Cruise**

2 – 3 hours Take a cruise on the **Ali’i Kai**, the world’s largest Polynesian catamaran. Sail “Hawaiian style,” in order to capture the beauty and excitement of Hawaii, dine on delicious cuisine, and relax with excellent Hawaiian style live entertainment.





# Aloha Music Festivals

## Day Aloha Stadium Flea Market

1 -2 hours  
Visit Hawaii's biggest outdoor swap meet with unbelievable bargains from hundreds of vendors selling everything from local arts and crafts, clothing, souvenirs, musical instruments, jewelry, luggage, sunglasses, shoes, accessories, house wares and much, much more. This is an ideal source for Hawaiian souvenirs.



## Performances & Clinics

### Day Ala Moana Center Stage

2 – 3 hours  
Perform at the **Ala Moana Shopping Center Stage**. Elevated stage can accommodate up to 70 performers. Subject to availability and approval, we may do an alternative performance at the Royal Hawaiian Shopping Center.



### Day Royal Hawaiian Center Stage

2 – 3 hours  
Perform at the **Royal Hawaiian Center**, located at Kalakaua Ave, the main tourist venue in Waikiki. The setting is in a stage area, decorated with Hawaiian culture motifs, open to the public. Stage can accommodate up to 50 performers.



### Day Hard Rock Café

2 - 3 hours  
**Perform** at the famous **Hard Rock Café**, Honolulu and then settle in for dinner. The elevated stage can accommodate up to 40 performers. Come hang ten at the Hard Rock Café, Honolulu. Take in the “Surfing Wall of Fame” and enjoy the “lush Lanai garden oasis” surrounding the café. The 138 Hard Rock Establishments, located all over the world, contain more than 70,000 pieces of memorabilia including guitars, drums, handwritten lyrics, costume pieces, and more – by far the largest, most valuable such collection in the world.



### Day Parade Performance

Full day  
Perform at one of Hawaii's most prestigious and popular parades:  
**Prince Kuhio Day Parade**, March 24, 2007  
**Celebration of Youth Parade**, April 14, 2007  
**Pan Pacific Parade & Festival**, June 8 – 10, 2007



### Day Exchange Performance with Royal Hawaiian Concert Band

2 -3 hours  
Exchange performances with the **Royal Hawaiian Concert Band**, Hawaii's most prestigious ensemble. Performances are typically held at the Kapiolani Band Stand, at Kapiolani Park in Waikiki. The Royal Hawaiian Concert Band is all adult performers. This is one of the oldest ensembles in Hawaii that carries the Hawaiian tradition of music from generation to generation. Stage can accommodate up to 100 performers.



**Day Exchange Performance with Hawaiian School**

2- 3 hours

Exchange performances with a **local high school ensemble**. Each school's musical ensemble(s) will perform for the other. You will have the opportunity to have a musical and cultural exchange of ideas. See how each school varies in their approach to music education and education in general.



**Day School Assembly Performance**

2 – 3 hours

Perform at a **local high school assembly**. Perform for students and faculty of a Hawaiian Public School in a concert setting. You may want to have one or more of your musical ensembles perform at this venue. (example: Concert Band, Wind Ensemble, Orchestra, String Ensemble, Choirs, Choral Ensembles, and Jazz Band)



**Day Polynesian Cultural Center Performance**

2- 3 hours

**Performance by your music ensemble** at the **Polynesian Cultural Center**. Usually combined with a full day visit to the Center. A great opportunity to perform in front of very large audience.



**Day Clinic at the University of Hawaii**

2 hours

Clinic is held at the **University of Hawaii**, near Waikiki. Clinics can be made available to any performing music ensemble with faculty members at the University of Hawaii. We also have available a music consultant and clinician on our Aloha Music Festival Staff.
